Inter- College Essay Contests

Under the leadership of Mr. Mahesh, we organized the Inter-College and Inter-Junior College Essay



competition at Hindupur. The essay contests

organizing committee had selected four topics, two for Junior college students (“The Right to Education” or “If there were no Human Rights”) and other two topics for degree students (“All right for



All” or “One of the articles in Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which right is the most important (Either to you, or to the society), and why?”). We also have decided to give cash award (1st Prize Rs. 1,000, 2nd Prize Rs. 750 and 3rd Prize 500) trophy and certificate for the winners. They have selected seventeen Degree and Junior colleges and visited the colleges for essay competitions. But only twelve colleges came forward to organize essay completion. Around 750 students (280 Degree students and 470 Junior Colleges students) participated in the competitions. On Dec 4th 2011 the contests papers were valued by RFYN Young Adults and the results were published on Dec 7th, 2011.
