On 19 December, 2011, the United Nations Declaration on Human Rights Education and Training was adopted by the General Assembly. The World Programme for Human Rights Education (2005-ongoing) is now in its second phase (2010-2014). At national and regional levels, a number of initiatives and activities have also been carried out.

In light of the existing policies on human rights education, Panel II will focus on the areas of human rights education in formal settings or environment including **the legal system in Cambodia and tertiary education in South Africa, as well as teacher training and the penal system in Switzerland**.
