Members and aspirant members of the IARF, representatives from different religious organizations celebrated together on the theme:

“PEACE and ALL GOOD”

There was an art exhibition, a concert with music from the 16th century Flemish composer Loeillet for church organ and flute. A dancer danced a prayer for peace “How to live” from the Hindu - tradition.

We read texts from the Bible, the Qur’an, the Bhagavad Gita and of Saint Francis of Assisi: all prayers for peace in the world and in ourselves. A vocal group sang hymns from the Taizé Community, together with the audience.

The celebration was closed by singing together: “This is my song, o God of all the nations” from the Unitarian tradition.

The ‘All Good’ was represented by an intercultural, vegetarian dinner: we shared food together.
