#### ABOUT THE VENUE:



SRI ADICHUNCHANAGIRI MAHASAMSTHANA\* is situated on a rocky hill at an altitude of about 3,300 ft., above sea level, 110 kms west of Bangalore, the capital of Karnataka, India. It has a history of 2000 years of its existence. It is the holy land engulfed with the divine resonance and vibration. Ancient Vedic culture was founded here on spirituality, where nature is valued and worshipped.

Sri Kshetra is surrounded by a beautiful forest, which appears to radiate an aura of abiding serenity, spiritual solitude and peace. This area is known as 'Mayura Vana', where enchanting peacocks live freely.

Millions look to this ancient Monastery, for both spiritual and mundane guidance. Apart from teaching spirituality, Sri Kshetra is set out to uplift the rural community through education and healthcare programs – the two most pressing needs of the society.

The Mutt is striving for the welfare and betterment of the common people, particularly those of rural areas. Several educational and technical institutions have been started in different places of the State including a Sanskrit college at Sri Kshetra. The service activities have increased many folds ever since Jagadguru Sri Sri Balagangadharanatha Mahaswamiji became the head of the Mutt in 1974. At present there are twelve branches of the Mutt. Seven Mutts receive patronage and more than 350 Educational Institutions 40 Mutts are managed by the Mutt. The mutt has branches in Kashi, Dharmapuri in Tamil Nadu, Selam and even in America. About 6,000 needy students are given free boarding and lodging and about 45,000 students are provided with general and technical education.

Sri Mutt serves free food to more than twenty thousand people every day.

# DEVELOPMENT THROUGH RELIGIOUS HARMONY Sri Mukthidananda Swamiji<sup>9</sup>, Ramakrishna Ashram, Mysore

SWAMIJI told that the role of religion is to ensure human progress. There exists a conflict between religion and science. Root of all is one. There is only one sun for all. Therefore no one can claim any uniqueness in religious. God is for all and formless. 'People who breathe intolerance and violence are anti-socials, he added.

Quoting Swami Vivekananda, he said "Religion is the manifestation of the divinity already in man".

Swamiji also related the story and philosophies of Sri Ramakrishna. "The greatest contribution of Sri Ramakrishna to the modern world is his message of the harmony of religions. To Sri Ramakrishna all religions are the revelation of God in His diverse aspects to satisfy the manifold demands of human minds. Like different photographs of a building taken from different angles, different religions give us the pictures of one truth from different standpoints. They are not contradictory but complementary. Sri Ramakrishna faithfully practiced the spiritual disciplines of different religions and came to the realization that all of them lead to the same goal. Thus he declared, "As many faiths, so many paths." The paths vary, but the goal remains the same. Harmony of religions is not uniformity; it is unity in diversity. It is not a fusion of religions, but a fellowship of religions based on their common goal -- communion with God. This harmony is to be realized by deepening our individual God-consciousness. In the present-day world,
